Dear friends,

"The righteous one rejoices in the Lord and takes refuge in Him; all those who are upright in heart will offer praise." Psalm 64:10 We are thankful that even when situations turn out differently than we might hope, we can still rejoice. What is interesting about this verse is that "rejoice" and "take refuge" are used together - meaning that even when we need to take refuge or find shelter from all those earthly things that distract us and challenge us, we can still rejoice and offer praise. How difficult that can be most of the time - our perspective needs to be beyond ourselves and what we "feel". Some of the items in this newsletter helps us understand this.

## **Update on Housemother Valya**

As most of you know, in February Valya went to the hospital with some symptoms and underwent a series of tests. After three weeks at one hospital and no diagnosis or conclusions, she went to another hospital for three weeks. (In between, she travelled to Crimea, in southern Ukraine, to take Yura for 6-8 weeks of physical therapy for his leg!) Finally there was a diagnosis of rheumatoid arthritis, which was consistent with some of the tests indicating an immune disorder. The doctors prescribed steroids for her, but we knew this was not a good long term solution. Since Donna was also diagnosed with this last year, and we have some other dear friends dealing with this, we were able to find appropriate non-steroid medications for Valya, and that she is able to obtain in Ukraine. Please continue to keep her in your prayers as she seeks relief from her pain with these medicines. It is good to have her back and functioning more normally again.
