Growing and Expanding

It is always a joy to welcome a new child to Brenna's Home! When we purchased the second apartment for Brenna's Home last May, we knew it was God's leading and provision. We don't always see the "entire plan", but we do not need to, we just need to be obedient when we are called.

This month (March), our third new child since last August arrived. Sasha is 14 years of age. Her mother recently died, the father's whereabouts are unknown, and her grandmother is sick. Children's Services contacted Vala and asked if she could live at Brenna's Home. Please pray for Sasha and her adjustment to Brenna's Home. The first two and 1/2 weeks have been very positive. Vala writes, "On April 5, we will have documents and legal consent for Sasha living at Brenna's Home. She likes everything here, helps me in the kitchen to prepare food. She wrote a poem where said about her new family and that her mother passed away but she got the new mother Dona though she did not see her yet. Only now she understands that family it is a happiness, it is all together at the table, there is no vodka and bad words. She liked all pictures with you and she liked you." (We had the opportunity to "meet" Sasha last week during a Skype call.) There is also a good possibility that we will be getting a 5-year old boy coming to Brenna's Home in the near future. This child has no official documents (for example, birth certificate), so until that is completed we can not have him live there. Perhaps we will know in our next newsletter.

Finishing work continues on the downstairs apartment (tiling the kitchen wall), and more work is being done to complete the project of expanding the balconies and joining them with the staircase. This will be one of the focus areas for our April fundraising efforts (see below).

APRIL Fundraising

We have several plans for fundraising during April this year. Last year we held a banquet at a local hotel, but decided that was too ambitious an undertaking at this point this year. We will be doing most of our fundraising this April through mail and personal contacts, with two goals in mind, increasing the number of individuals and/or groups that commit to sponsoring a child in Brenna's Home (\$25/month) on a regular basis. We would like to grow our regular sponsor list from 20 to 50, this is especially critical with the new children, as our monthly expenses increase. We also look for general donations to cover an additional \$5000 to cover the rest of the project for connecting the two apartments and for some specific medical needs for several of the children.
